

Reporting Abuse

Domain name registrants are required to use and manage their domain names under the terms of their registration agreement. The registration agreement and its terms of service prohibit the registration and use of the domain name for certain purposes, including for the distribution of malware, the operation of abusive botnets, phishing, or other activity contrary to applicable law.

We take reports of abuse seriously. If you need to report that a domain name registered through us is being used for an abusive or malicious purpose, you may send an email to: domainabuse@domains.best or send us postal mail at the address below.

Abuse reports should identify (a) your name and contact information, including your postal address, email address, and a telephone number at which you can be reached; (b) the domain name that is the cause of, or associated with, your report; (c) the nature of the harm caused, with sufficient detail for us to investigate your report; and (d) whether the harm is current and ongoing. Abuse reports that contain each of these elements will be given priority.

Reports from law enforcement, consumer protection agencies, or quasi-governmental or other similar authorities should identify the name of the relevant agency and the jurisdiction in which it operates. We endeavour respond to all reports from law enforcement or related agencies within twenty-four (24) hours.
